The two-day weekend retreat offers the opportunity to meet fellow survivors and participate in discussions led by Radiation Oncologists, Urologists and other cancer experts.

The retreat is available for men who have been diagnosed with prostate or testicular cancer and have recently completed treatment or have been in remission for many years.

- Dealing with chronic effects of treatment and medications
- Restoring one's sense of joy in the area of sensuality and sexuality
- Physical wellness through exercise and healthy nutrition
